2. Poland (Women) finished in 6th place in the EuroHockey Indoor Nations Championships 2010, so the final qualification place (Europe 6th) is given to the first placed team from the Indoor Nations Trophy (Women) 2010.
3. If any continent does not take up their full quota, then the vacant place(s) will be allocated according to the final ranking positions from the 2007 Indoor World Cup.
